

BATTS Junior Pairs Competition

Who will be the dynamic duo?

Following hot on the heels of our very successful Junior Open League at BATTS we have a brand new competition starting in April.

BATTS Junior Pairs is not a league, but will give youngsters plenty of opportunities to compete in teams against other players involving both singles and doubles.

WHO CAN ENTER?

The BATTS Junior Pairs competition is open to all junior players (ie born in 1999 or later).

Everyone is welcome to enter – you do not have to be a member of BATTS.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Before the start of each session, we shall rank all entrants on the basis of previous results and known playing strength. There will be a two “divisions”. At the beginning of each session, players will be put in a pair and the two will form a team - for that afternoon only.

Please note that players will not be able to choose their partners – the pairings will be determined by the organisers on the day. In the second and subsequent sessions it is likely that players will have a new partner, but that depends on who plays each time.

The match will consist of FOUR singles, with both players playing singles against each of the opposing team and then ONE doubles. During the afternoon each pair will play two matches.

As with the BATTS Junior Open League each rubber will consist of THREE games.

We are confident that this will enable all players to have plenty of competition during the afternoon.

We expect to finish at about 4pm.

At the end of each afternoon’s play we shall award a prize to the most successful pair during that session. Every game will count!

WHEN?

The Junior Pairs Competition will take place on the following four Saturday afternoons. As with the Junior Open League, BATTS will open at noon, we ask for all players to arrive by 12.30pm to register, and play starts at 1pm each day:

1. SATURDAY 22ND APRIL
2. SATURDAY 13TH MAY
3. SATURDAY 3RD JUNE
4. SATURDAY 1ST JULY

HOW MUCH?

The cost of entering the Junior Pairs Competition is £24 and entries will only be confirmed on receipt of your payment. The single payment of £24 entitles a player to participate on all four dates.

HOW TO ENTER?

If you would like to enter our Junior Pairs Competition you should complete the online entry form very soon as places will be limited to ensure that all players get plenty of games during the sessions.
