

TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

1. ETTA Tournament Regulations apply to this tournament inc. Reg. R, racket (rerubbing). ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply except those relating to the matters covered by items marked (x) in this entry form.
2. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Player Member to the ETTA Ltd or of another National Association in membership of the ITTF.
3. Completion and submission of this entry form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition including the variations from ITTF requirements.
4. Entrants in events 1 and 2 must have been born after 31st December 1992, in events 3 and 4 after 31st December 1994, in events 5 and 6 after 31st December 1995 and in events 7 and 8 after 31st December 1997.
5. Competitors will be permitted to practice on tables not in use at the discretion of the referee.
6. All events will be drawn into groups of 3 or 4 dependent on entry. All matches will be the best of five games up to eleven. In a group or "round robin" competition, each member of the group shall compete against every other member; 2 match points shall be awarded for a win, 1 for a loss in a played match and 0 for a loss in an unplayed match, and the ranking order shall be determined primarily by the number of match points gained. If at the completion of the group 2 or more members of the group have gained the same number of match points, the equalities shall be resolved as per ITTF regulations 3.7.5.2 or 3.7.5.3.
Where time permits, a consolation event will be held for players not progressing from their groups to the KO stages.
7. The top two placed players will advance from their groups into the knockout tournament. Players placed in any other position will advance to a Consolation event (if time permits).
8. All competitors may be required to umpire at least one match in each event entered. Each match will be controlled by an Umpire whose decision will be final on all matters of fact, the decision of the Referee being final on all matters of law.
9. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
10. Players clothing: Main colour of clothing must be different from colour of ball (x).
11. All competitors must report to the control table on arrival, and must not leave the venue without first obtaining permission from the Control Table.
12. Doping shall not take place either before or during play.
13. No "gluing up" will be allowed in the sports hall or in any part of the venue. No gluing with glue containing volatile substances is permitted.
14. No entry will be accepted unless the following undertaking on the entry form is signed:
(i) To observe the regulations of the tournament; (ii) To abide by the decision of the Referee and the organising committee; (iii) To fulfill the schedule of play arranged for me unless prevented by circumstances beyond my control and accepted as such by the Referee.
